In an emergency and to be followed for training exercises:

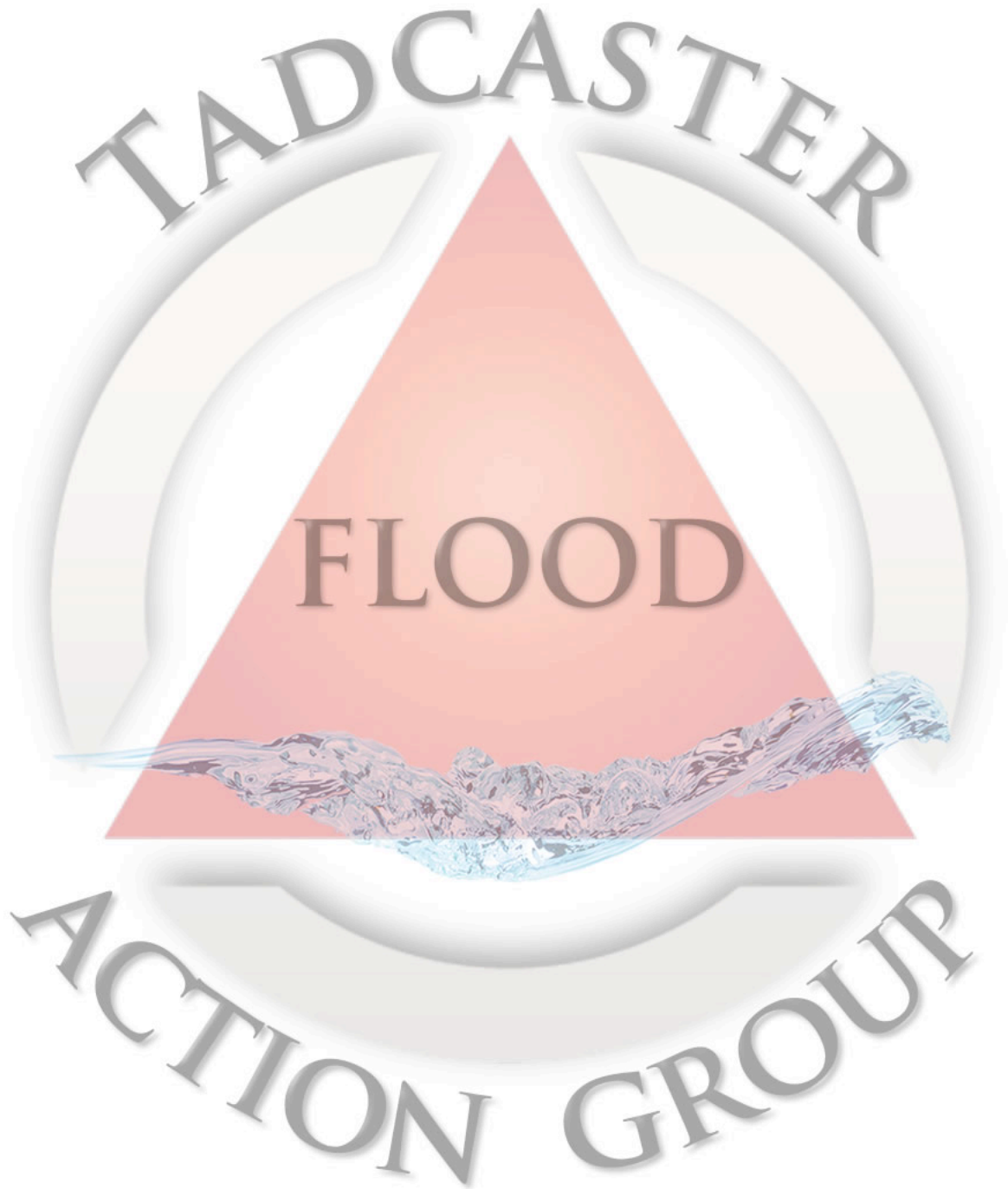
- All volunteers must wear appropriate water proof clothing and footwear.
- All volunteers must register on Bridge Street and read group's terms as below.
- All volunteers must work under instruction from the Senior Coordinators and with the authorities.
- The minimum number of volunteers for our primary plan is 14 with an ideal number of 20. (If there is not adequate numbers, the Coordinators will reassess groups)
- 14 HF radios will be distributed to each group, if working with 14 volunteers, each volunteer to carry a radio.
- PPE (HI vis vest, gloves and glasses) must be worn at all times and not handed out to non-volunteers. Orange hi-vis vests are available for non-trained volunteers: these volunteers are merely borrowing equipment and are not working directly under the Flood Action Group.
- All volunteers are to maintain radio contact and remain in pairs for safety.
- All volunteers and equipment must be evacuated if there is an immanent risk of flooding.
- All sandbags need to be signed out, there is a maximum of 10 per residential property and 20 per business. Any further sandbags required to be assessed by a Coordinator.
- First aid points are with each Coordinator.

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- Abusive behaviour from volunteers is not tolerated and any volunteer demonstrating this behaviour will be asked immediately to leave the area.
- Volunteers do not have the authority to close roads.
- All volunteers must return PPE, radios and sign out.



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
